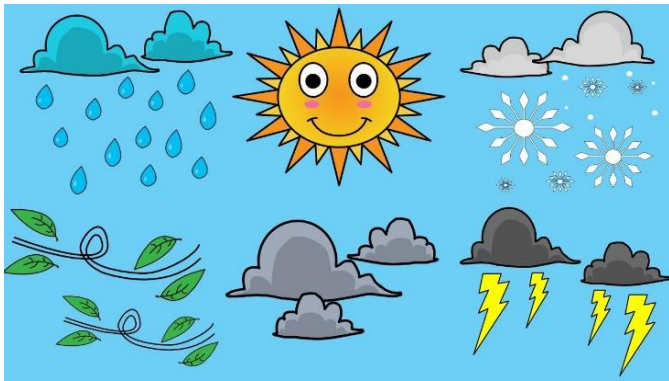

## What is this topic?

In this topic we will be looking at the daily weather and how this changes from day to day. We will be recording the weather and looking at the temperature daily. We will then compare our weather to the weather of a hot country and a cold country. We will become pattern spotters and see if we can spot any weather patterns. We will also look at what the equator is and where this is on a globe.



## Key Vocabulary

Temperature	Region or climate characterised by hot or cold air.
Equator	A line drawn on the Earth to split the Earth into the Northern and Southern Hemisphere.
Weather	The way the air and atmosphere feels.
Seasons	One of the 4 across a year characterised by weather and day light patterns.

## Key knowledge

- ❖ There are 4 seasons in total. Spring, summer, autumn and winter.
- ❖ The temperature is recorded on a thermometer.
- ❖ The Equator runs around the middle of the Earth.
- ❖ The closer we are to the equator the hotter the temperature.
- ❖ The further away we are the colder the temperature.

- ❖ Where the equator is on the Earth and where we are in comparison.
- ❖ How to record the weather and spot changes and patterns each day.
- ❖ Where a country hotter than the UK is and the reasons for this.
- ❖ Where a country colder than the UK is and the reasons for this.
