These are words that can't be sounded out and need to be learnt by sight. The children are working hard to learn these in class.



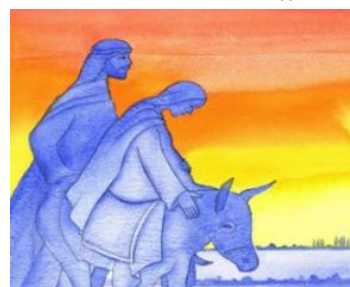
In R.E. we have been thinking about Mary and Joseph and their long journey to Bethlehem. The children have been sharing their ideas of how Mary and Joseph felt.
