Wow, who can believe we are actually in the Summer term - the year has flown by.

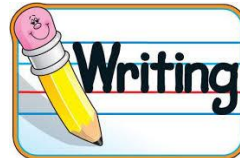
It was lovely to have Rachel visit us from the Library on Thursday.
