
HISTORY - ANGLO SAXONS - YEAR 5











Key vocabulary	Definition
BCE (was BC)	Before Common Era (was before Christ)
CE	Common Era (was AD – Anno Domini – Year of our Lord)
Invade	To enter and occupy land.
Settlement	A colony or any small community of people.
Romans	Romans invaded and settled in Britain for over 400 years.
Angles	Tribes from modern day Denmark and Germany.
Saxons	Tribes from modern day Denmark and Germany.
Picts	Tribes originally from Scotland who were 'foul' and had a 'lust for blood'.
Scots	Tribes originally from Ireland, who, like the Picts, were fierce and powerful
	fighters.
Pagan	A religion where many gods and goddesses are worshipped.
Hadrian's wall	Built by Emperor Hadrian to keep the Picts out of Britain.
Offa's Dyke	An earth wall and ditch ordered by Offa, king of Mercia to border Wales.
Egbert	First Anglo-Saxon king to rule England.
Harold II	Last Anglo-Saxon king to rule in 1066
Sutton Hoo	Excavation site revealing some of the most well-preserved artefacts ever found.
